Instructor of Record Tested Experience-Based Qualifications for Academic Programs

Each academic unit has the responsibility to ensure that credentials of instructor of record satisfy Higher Learning Commissions criteria for determining qualified faculty, NDSU's Minimum Qualifications for Instructional Faculty Policy, and any applicable accreditation standards for the academic program. Instructor of record faculty credentials and approvals apply to all NDSU credit-bearing and developmental courses.

In general, instructors will be qualified based on academic qualifications as defined in <u>Policy 309</u>. In some cases, instructors who do not meet the minimum academic qualifications but possess substantial tested experience may be appointed to teach courses. In these cases, academic units (chairs/heads/program directors working with program faculty) must document minimum tested experience-based qualifications for their programs.

Course Level	Tested Experience-Based Qualifications
Example: XXX 100-299 courses	BS degree, Certification in YYY, and at least 3 years of documented excellent in teaching similar courses as demonstrated by teaching awards and/or teaching reviews.
Example: Undergraduate	BS degree and at least 10 years work experience in field to be taught as demonstrated by completion of XXX certificate or WWW license.
Example: Graduate	MS degree, Certification in ZZZ, 15 years work experience in field, and appropriate scholarship.
