

Workshop on collegiality scheduled

Robert Cipriano, professor emeritus and former chair of the Department of Recreation and Leisure Studies at Southern Connecticut State University, is scheduled to be at NDSU on Wednesday, Nov. 6, to discuss collegiality with faculty and academic administrators.

Cipriano will lead two workshops titled “Fostering a Collegial Department: The Role of the Administrators and Senior Faculty.” In the interactive workshop, the attendees will actively participate in problem-solving activities regarding the topic of collegiality within a department, as well as campuswide. Experiential and hands-on case studies and scenarios will be used to explore questions of collegiality. The first session will be open to all faculty and will run from 9 a.m. to noon in the Memorial Union Arikara room. The second session is designed for college deans and department chairs and heads and will be held from 1:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the NDSU Alumni Center.
