

Request to Delay Graduate School Enrollment

- You may delay your enrollment for a maximum of one year. If you delay enrollment more than one year, you must reapply to the Graduate School.
- If admitted conditionally, the conditions listed in your original acceptance letter would still apply.
- Your academic department will determine if any funding offered at the time of initial admission will still be available.
- If you have registered for courses, you must properly withdraw from the university by completing the Cancellation of Registration / Withdrawing to Zero Credits form. Failure to initiate the withdrawal process may result in failing grades and possible financial obligations.
