

### **Maxine Buehler – Diploma 1947 Bismarck Hospital School of Nursing**

Maxine Buehler, 88, Bismarck, passed away December 30, 2014. Services will be held at 3:00 pm Friday, January 2, 2015, at Parkway Funeral Service, 2330 Tyler Parkway, Bismarck. Visitation will be held one hour prior to the service at the funeral home. Burial will be held in the spring in Washburn, ND.
