<sup>2</sup> Tuition is estimated for Fall and Spring terms for full-time enrollment. Full-time academic is 13-18 credits per term and full-time IELP is 20 credits per term.

<sup>3</sup> These annual fees include: university activity fee, technology fee, library fee, career services, health/wellness fee, Connect ND fee, and an \$85 International Student Support Services fee each semester.

<sup>4</sup> These are one-time fees for all new international students. This includes a \$200 undergraduate fee which supports the Office of Student Success Programs and a \$75 international orientation fee which supports the Office of International Student and Study Abroad Services.

<sup>5</sup> This estimate reflects shared living accommodations with another student and 7-day meal plan for the academic year (9 months).

<sup>6</sup> All students are required to purchase the mandatory state health insurance policy, and this fee is charged at the beginning of each semester upon enrollment, except for citizens of Canada and Norway. Canadian and Norwegian residents may request an exemption to this requirement, but any exceptions to this are determined post-admission and post issuance of an I-20 for F-1 students. See <https://www.ndsu.edu/international/iss/insurance>. J-1 students are required to have the mandatory policy regardless of country of origin.

<sup>7</sup> Books and supplies are estimated for Fall and Spring terms. Actual charges vary based on the program.
