## 1. What would I do about submitting my immunization records if my records are in my assigned legal birth name and not my current legal name?

Immunization records must contain your name, date of birth, and student ID number. If possible, change the name on your immunization records to your current legal name. It should work to submit your immunization records even with your previous legal name if they have your NDSU student ID number and your date of birth. If additional documentation is needed submit a documented letter stating your new legal name to the Student Health Service.

## 5. Can I use NDSU's Student Health Services for my hormone prescription?

Yes, ask your doctor to send your prescription to the Pharmacy at NDSU's Student Health Center and you can pick it up there.

# 6. Can I change my username that I use to log into my electronic accounts?

Yes, please contact IT Help Desk at 701-231-8685 (option 1) or bring your NDSU ID Card to the IT Help Desk in Quentin Burdick Bldg 150 to request to change your username. The username will be changed to the following accounts: NDSU electronic ID, N.D. University System ID, and NDSU email address. This may take more than 5 business days to complete, and your request will not change the display name for each of these accounts. To change your display name, you must change your preferred name.

# 7. How can I go about setting up my preferred name for my electronic accounts?

A preferred name can be set for a first and/or last name. The preferred name will appear in your email display name, Blackboard, online directory, and other electronic systems that are used. Please note, the 'Legal' name listed in Campus Connection is how your name will appear on your diploma.

Steps to setup preferred name:

- 1.Log in to Campus Connection and in your Student Center under the "Personal Information" heading click 'Demographic Data'
- 2.Select "Names" and click "edit" button shown next to "Preferred Name"
- 3. Update Preferred name & click "save"

- 9. How do I go about changing my legal name and gender on my official NDSU academic records (e.g. transcripts, Campus Connection)?

Name Changes: If you wish to change your 'Legal' name (name verified by a birth certificate, passport, court order, etc.), you must complete a Name Change Request Form (available on the One Stop Forms page in the Registration & Records tab under STUDENT RECORDS) and provide official documentation stating your new legal name to the Office of Registration and Records. Upon receipt & verification of this documentation, the registrar will change your name in your official academic record.

**Gender Changes:** You must provide the registrar with a *certified copy of a court order* showing your change of name and "good faith" statement from you stating a request for a gender change.
