Eligibility

- Satisfactory academic progress
- Preference will be given to those applicants who have not already received this scholarship

Applications sought from persons of diverse backgrounds, particularly those from traditionally underrepresented communities and demographic groups.

Award Terms

- To be applied to tuition, books, and/or fees through Financial Aid
- Valid only for the 2015-2016 academic year
- Award will be reported to Student Financial Services as a scholarship

Judging Criteria

- Applicants' affirmation of multicultural identity and/or commitment to the multicultural community
- Evidence of academic success at the university
- Evidence of serving, leading and working for change in multicultural communities, including as a role model, mentor, and/or adviser.
