North Dakota State
University is pleased to
offer the Cultural Diversity
Tuition Discount to qualified
students. For the purpose of
the Cultural Diversity Tuition
Discount, cultural diversity
is defined as anyone who
comes from the following
underrepresented groups:

- Native American/American Indian (priority given to enrolled members of a tribe)
- Alaskan Native (priority given to enrolled members of a village)
- · African American/Black
- Asian
- Native Hawaiian/Other Pacific Islander
- · Hispanic/Latino
- Multiracial/Multiethnic (from the above categories)
- Refugee

Diversity Discount Procedures

To be considered for the Cultural Diversity Tuition Discount, **you must**:

- Be admitted to North Dakota State University by April 1, 2016.
- Submit the Cultural Diversity Tuition Discount Application by April 1, 2016.
- Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), indicating NDSU's school code of 002997. Information from the FAFSA is used in the awarding of the Cultural Diversity Tuition Discount. To be considered, you must submit your FAFSA free of errors by March 1, 2016. Please note this is prior to the April 15, 2016, priority deadline for FAFSA completion at NDSU.
- Include tribal documentation with your Cultural Diversity Discount Application if you are an enrolled member of a tribe.
- If you are a permanent resident, refugee or a student in the process of obtaining permanent residency, you must provide a copy of your I-94, I-551, Permanent Residency Card, or other immigration documentation with your Cultural Diversity Tuition Discount Application.

Priority is given to:

- Students with high financial need (based on results of the completed 2016-2017 FAFSA as of April 1, 2016)
- · First generation college students
- Full-time students at North Dakota State University
- Students who are single parents

Due to the limited number of awards available, all students who meet the definition of cultural diversity are **not** guaranteed a Cultural Diversity Tuition Discount. To apply for the discount, a complete Cultural Diversity Tuition Discount application, with necessary documentation, must be received in the Office of Admission by April 1, 2016.

Cultural Diversity Tuition Discount Awards

- The Cultural Diversity Tuition Discount is included as part of your financial aid award package.
- The Cultural Diversity Tuition Discount does not exceed the amount of North Dakota full-time undergraduate resident base tuition. It does not cover transportation, fees, books, room, board or other costs of attendance.
- · The tuition discount may be reduced if the student receives certain veteran's benefits.
- The Cultural Diversity Tuition Discount does not cover distance education, continuing education or self-support courses.
- Undergraduate Cultural Diversity Tuition Discounts will expire after five consecutive years.
- For master's degree students, the Cultural Diversity Tuition Discount cannot exceed two years or six semesters.
- For doctoral students the Cultural Diversity Tuition Discount cannot exceed three years or nine semesters.
- You are only allowed one Cultural Diversity Tuition Discount at NDSU.
- Each recipient is required to meet with a representative from the Office of Multicultural Programs each semester enrolled at NDSU.


