  - Plans for report to the Ag. Committee regarding the Sand and Gravel Report is to survey the SCD's – Sand & Gravel Contractors and County Weed Boards – identify importance of this report. – Survey Questions
  - The SSCC compiled and are submitting actual number of SCD FTE's – 54 – 116 part-time numbers given at review.
  - Decided to add a line for Supervisors signature to the SCDAP fund request forms starting February 1<sup>st</sup> 2018.

  - Bruce Schmidt has started discussion with Dan Folkse to update the on-line training and the Supervisor Handbook ASAP and if he can't than District Director Jim Gray has plans for a possible replacement.
