- Students will use FlipGrid to answer <u>2 questions</u> posed by the committee.
- The questions will **not** be available ahead of time.
- The questions and FlipGrid will be open for 8 hours on Saturday, April 23rd, 2022.
 - o 8 am to 4 pm CST
- Directions for using FlipGrid are available on the nursing application website.

 - You will need to log in using a Microsoft or Google account
 - Your NDUS email address will also work
- Student responses will remain private and confidential.
- Responses for each question should be 2 minutes in length
- Please remember that this is your first introduction to the Admissions Committee
 - Be sure to set aside enough time on <u>Saturday</u>, <u>April 23rd</u>, <u>2022</u> to focus on answering the questions.
 - o Place your First/Last name in the title of your video response.
 - o Consider writing out answers to the questions before creating your recording (but avoid reading from a script).
 - o Treat the FlipGrid response as if you are giving a speech in COMM 110.
 - o Dress appropriately (professional attire).
 - o Use appropriate language and grammar.
 - o DO NOT stop and start your presentation.
 - o Consider your environment; avoid loud areas, distracting backgrounds, etc.

Transcripts

 - Transcripts <u>do not</u> need to be sent to the nursing department.
- If you are taking courses in the spring semester at a school other than NDSU, you will need to have transcripts sent to the NDSU Registration and Records office as soon as grades are posted.
 - Students planning to apply to the Fargo site, you are <u>required</u> to contact your pre-nursing academic advisor via email to provide course(s) you are taking elsewhere
- Grades from summer semester will NOT be considered in the admission decision to the Fargo site.

- April 30th, 2022: Health Sciences Reasoning Test (HSRT)
 - o Applicants will sign up for a testing time
 - o Testing will take place at NDSU in an on-campus computer lab

Important Dates-Bismarck Site

- April 23rd, 2022: FlipGrid is open from 8 am to 4 pm
- All students applying to the nursing program will take the Kaplan Admissions Exam.
 Test dates will be May 16th 27th
 - You will be notified by email regarding how to register for an exam day and time.
