

2022 Pre-licensure BSN Track Application Instructions

***Read and follow the instructions below**

The applicant is responsible for ensuring all components of the application are completed and received by:

- **Fargo site: April 20 for both fall and spring program start**
- **Bismarck site: April 20 for fall admission, and October 20 for spring admission**

Contact Information

- Name
- Email address - You are strongly encouraged to use your current North Dakota University System email address (NDSU, BSC, etc.)
 - Email will be the primary mode of communication regarding your application status. Provide an email address that you check regularly.
 - Ensure that the email address is correct (spelling, etc.).
 - If a copy of the completed application is not received via e-mail, check the junk mail folder, and then contact the SON. This likely means your provided e-mail is incorrect.
- Address - where you will be living this summer
- NDUS ID

Campus Selection

- Fargo only, Bismarck only, or Either Location. For more information about the NDSU Nursing sites, please go online to <https://www.ndsu.edu/nursing/about/> .
 - If 'Either Location' is selected, indicate which site is preferred and if you have applied to the NDSU nursing program before.
 - By selecting "Either" you are indicating you are able and willing to complete the entire nursing program at either site.
 - For those applying to Fargo only or Either with Fargo first choice:
 - Select preferred semester to start the professional program
 - Fall 2022 or Spring 2023

- Use code NO96 in the PLACE ORDER box. Follow directions to continue the order and pay the **\$55.75** fee for the background check. Please note, the “O” is the letter “O” and not a zero.
- This fee is in addition to the program application fee
- The School of Nursing will receive your background check once submitted; you do not need to contact us.

Personal Statement

- Students will use FlipGrid to answer **2 questions** posed by the committee.
- The questions will **not** be available ahead of time.
- The questions and FlipGrid will be open for **8 hours** on **Saturday, April 23rd, 2022**.
 - 8 am to 4 pm CST
- Directions for using FlipGrid are available on the nursing application website.

 - You will need to log in using a Microsoft or Google account
 - Your NDUS email address will also work
- Student responses will remain private and confidential.
- Responses for each question should be **2 minutes in length**
- Please remember that this is your first introduction to the Admissions Committee
 - Be sure to set aside enough time on **Saturday, April 23rd, 2022** to focus on answering the questions.
 - Place your First/Last name in the title of your video response.
 - Consider writing out answers to the questions before creating your recording (but avoid reading from a script).
 - Treat the FlipGrid response as if you are giving a speech in COMM 110.
 - Dress appropriately (professional attire).
 - Use appropriate language and grammar.
 - DO NOT stop and start your presentation.
 - Consider your environment; avoid loud areas, distracting backgrounds, etc.

Transcripts

- Ensure transcripts from all schools attended (other than NDSU) were submitted to the Admissions office with your University application.
 - Transcripts do not need to be sent to the nursing department.
- If you are taking courses in the spring semester at a school other than NDSU, you will need to have transcripts sent to the NDSU Registration and Records office as soon as grades are posted.
 - **Students planning to apply to the Fargo site, you are required to contact your pre-nursing academic advisor via email to provide course(s) you are taking elsewhere**
- Grades from summer semester will NOT be considered in the admission decision to the Fargo site.

Important Dates- Fargo Site

- **April 23rd 2022:** FlipGrid is open from 8 am to 4 pm
- **April 30th, 2022:** Health Sciences Reasoning Test (HSRT)
 - Applicants will sign up for a testing time
 - Testing will take place at NDSU in an on-campus computer lab

Important Dates- Bismarck Site

- **April 23rd, 2022:** FlipGrid is open from 8 am to 4 pm
- All students applying to the nursing program will take the Kaplan Admissions Exam.
Test dates will be May 16th – 27th
 - You will be notified by email regarding how to register for an exam day and time.
