


MediQHome was launched by Blue Cross and Blue Shield of North Dakota in 2009 and is an example of a patient-centered medical home. If your primary physician has chosen to participate in MediQHome and you have a chronic condition, you are automatically part of the program. It is available to all North Dakota residents at no additional cost. Your primary physician will coordinate your care and communicate with other participating providers you may see.

73% of North Dakota's primary care providers belong to a MediQHome and 75-80% of BCBSND members participate. BCBSND provides administrative support and financial incentives for primary care physicians to use MediQHome. A software tool, called MDInsight, automates the collection of clinical data from existing medical records, lab, registry systems, and transcribed notes and then sends out patient care management reports to participating providers.

MediQHome tracks the following preventive services and chronic conditions: asthma, Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), diabetes, chronic heart failure, coronary artery disease, hypertension, cervical cancer screening, breast cancer screening, colon cancer screening and immunizations.
