# College Leadership

- **Arts and Sciences** – Kimberly Wallin remains dean
- **Engineering** – Alan Kallmeyer remains as interim dean; national search to begin fall 2024
- **Business** – Search underway, on-campus interviews expected in March/April
- **Health Professions and Human Sciences** – Internal search for interim to begin immediately. National search to begin Fall 2023
- **Agriculture, Food Systems and Natural Resources** – TBD

# Provost Leadership

- 3-year term, followed by search
- Unanimous support from Deans
- Support from SBHE Chancellor & SBHE Chairman
- Critical to have deep knowledge and experience of our current challenges and opportunities
- Critical for stability during 2-3 year transformation process
- Critical for dean searches

# Strategic Academic Reductions

- Academic FTE Reductions
  - January proposal: 34.5 FTE
  - After feedback and review: 27.5 FTE
- Two dean positions
- All units and personnel affected by these reductions have already been contacted

# Strategic Academic Reductions

- Academic departments/programs
  - Earth, Environmental and Geospatial Sciences
  - Hospitality and Event Management
  - Agricultural Systems Management
- Tenured faculty/programs/students
  - Details to be discussed during consultations as required by NDSU Policy 350.3
  - All students affected will be able to complete their current majors



# Strategic Non-Academic Reductions

- Non-academic reductions
  - Real estate lease
  - Operational budget reductions
  - Athletics budget reductions
  - Auxiliary budget reductions
  - Other efficiencies
- All units affected by these reductions have already been contacted

# Strategic Investments

- **Professional advising.** All 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year students. Helps students and reduces faculty workload.
- **New programs -** Meet workforce needs and new markets in online and in-person.
- **Bison Bridge program -** We will revitalize this initiative, learning from our past efforts, to prioritize how we recruit, retain, and invest in first-generation, Pell-eligible, and students of color.
