General Information:

The BeYou L+ Health project is focused on surveying the LBGTQS+ population related to HIV/STIs, COVID, access to care, and other health-related issues.

Responsibilities:

Two GAs will work with the principal investigator (Dr. Johnson) on development and implementation of a health survey. Activities include finalizing the survey instrument and sampling plan, administering the survey at 4 Pride events (1 each in Fargo, Grand Forks, Bismarck, and Minot), cleaning and conducting preliminary analysis, and other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Prefer demonstrated knowledge, interest, and/or work experience in the area of L+ health
- Prefer experience working or interacting with the L+ population
- Prefer completion of PH 754 Health Survey Research or another survey methods course
- Prefer experience with outreach or recruitment activities
- Must be admitted to the NDSU MPH program or related field
- Must maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA for duration of the appointment
- Must be able to travel to Fargo, Grand Forks, Bismarck, and Minot
- Ability to work independently and carry out tasks to completion
- Strong oral, written, and interpersonal communication skills in the English language
- Proficient in computer skills and document preparation (e.g., Microsoft Office)

Terms of Employment:

Two GAs needed for summer travel to Pride events across ND. One or both may continue into fall semester. Appointment requires 10-20 hours per week. Appointment can begin as early as May 23, 2022 and ends May 19, 2023. Renewal each semester (summer, fall, spring) is dependent on satisfactory performance. Continuation after the first semester is dependent on performance and availability of funds. The appointee must be able to travel across ND.

The assistantship pays \$16/hour and comes with a base tuition waiver covering the graduate school portion of the tuition. The Public Health tuition is the responsibility of the student.
