Exceptions to Academic Standing (Spring 2020)

- 1. No academic suspensions at the close of the spring semester at the UGRD level.
- 2. Academic standing will be determined on the cumulative GPA (CGPA). <u>Note</u>: Normally standing is determined factoring both the semester GPA and CGPA.
- 3. Students receiving all pass grades will retain the same academic standing as they had when they entered the spring 2020 semester. Rational: Since pass grades do not factor into the GPA (i.e. they don't help or hinder GPA), the standing will remain unchanged from the previous semester.
