Elective Requirements for MIS Major - 12 credits

- 1) Programming Language Course 3 credits CSCI 125, ECE 173 or an intermediate or advanced CSCI course that was not the teaching language of CSCI 227/228
- 2) Technology Elective I 3 credits from approved Technology Elective list
- 3) Technology Elective II 3 credits any 300-400 level CSCI or MIS course not used to satisfy another MIS major requirement
- 4) Business Elective 3 credits any 300-400 level CoB course not used to satisfy other requirements, CSCI 473, or ECON 324. (Excludes internships, study abroad, LEAD courses & MIS 371)

DEGREE ELECTIVES - 5 CREDITS TO REACH 130

Degree Requirements and Notes:

- Business courses from programs that do not hold AACSB International accreditation cannot be used for major
 or minor requirements in the College of Business (CoB); such courses may be eligible for use as free elective.
- The CoB accepts a maximum of nine credits of non-NDSU 300-400 level business courses from AACSB programs with approval of the department.

- Admission into the MIS Major: Students must successfully complete the pre-college and pre-mis courses that are indicated with an asterisk (*), achieve junior standing (60 credits), and earn a 2.50 institutional cumulative grade point average. Students must submit an application to the CoB.
- Admission to the MIS major is required to enroll in the advanced 300 or 400 level courses in the CoB.
- A grade of C or better is required in transfer courses accepted for ACCT 200 and 201 and all 300-400 level accounting, business administration, finance, management, mis, and marketing courses.
- A letter grade must be earned in any course that fulfills a major requirement.
- Requirements for graduation are those in existence at the time of admission to the MIS major.
- A grade of C or better is required for all courses with an MIS, CSCI, or ECE prefix.
- A 2.50 cumulative grade point average is required to enroll in 300-400 level CoB courses.
- Students must earn a 2.50 institutional GPA to graduate.
- Of the credits completed in residence at least 30 credits must be in 300-400 level CoB courses.
- Students must be accepted to the MIS major prior to the completion of the last 30 credits in 300 and 400 level CoB courses.
- A Business Administration minor is NOT offered with this major.
- For multiple majors within the CoB, at least 15 unique credits of 300-400 level CoB courses must exist between the majors.
