# Proposal for Integrative Senior Project - 1 Credit

A written proposal is to be submitted to the Director of the International Studies Major and the student's senior project advisor. The proposal will be graded and must be done PRIOR to project completion.

Approved, 10-week or equivalent experience spent abroad in an approved program.

## **Major Requirements and Notes:**

• The General Education component is to be completed with the student's choice of primary major. Courses for the International Studies core may not double count as general education for the primary major. However, courses meeting general education requirements for global perspectives and cultural diversity may count as electives.
