- Grades in any two consecutive undergraduate studio courses (ARCH 271, 272, 371, 372, 471, 472) must average 2.5 or better.

A student must complete at least 60 semester credits of professional level course work in his/her program while in residence and enrolled in the college. Students transferring into the college from programs with professional accreditation are exempt from this residency requirement but are subject to the residency requirement of NDSU.
