 - General Student Population GPA: 3.117
 - Overall Student-Athlete GPA: 3.428
 - Women's Sports Average GPA: 3.640
 - Men's Sports Average GPA: 3.266
 - Team GPA Records:
 - Women's Cross-Country Semester GPA: 3.737
 - Women's Volleyball Semester GPA: 3.806
 - Fall 2023 Semester GPA at a glance:
 - 329 Student-athletes earned a GPA of 3.0 or higher in Fall 2023 (78.0%)
 - 107 Student-athletes had a PERFECT 4.0 GPA in Fall 2023!! (25.4%)
 - 240 Student-athletes earned Dean's List recognition (3.5-4.0 GPA) (56.9%)
 - Student Athlete Cumulative GPA at a glance:
