Student Health Service

- Funded by student health and wellness fees
- No office charge to see a physician or midlevel-practitioner
- Reasonable fees charged for the following:
 - Laboratory Services
 - Immunizations and Injections
 - Treatments
 - Medications
 - X-rays

Student Health Service

Insurance

- **Students are responsible** for filing insurance claims for treatments, procedures, injections, radiology and laboratory services
- The Student Health Service will provide students with an itemized statement for filing to health insurance companies
- The Student Health Service Pharmacy is able to process claims with most insurance companies

Student Health Service

Insurance

- Domestic students are not required to have insurance to receive care at the Student Health Service
- Students are encouraged to obtain an accident and sickness insurance plan if they are not covered under an insurance policy
 - **StudentBLUE** insurance is available through Blue Cross BlueShield of North Dakota

Primary Health Care

- Respiratory, urinary tract, skin and other infections
- Asthma, hypertension, elevated cholesterol and other common chronic health conditions
- Non-complex mental health disorders
 - Depression
 - Anxiety
 - ADHD
- Gastrointestinal problems
- Gynecological issues
- Orthopedic injuries
- Sexually transmitted infection screenings

- Tobacco Cessation
 - Treatment planning, education, support and follow-up
 - Free Nicotine Replacement Products
 - (Gums, Lozenges, Patches)
- Contraception education
- STD testing education
- HIV rapid testing
- Other needs-based programming designed to address health and wellness issues impacting academic success
 - incorporating the ***7 Dimensions of Wellness***

Student Health Service

Radiology Services

- Digital X-ray images are completed using state-of-the-art computer radiography technology
- Staffed by licensed radiologic technologists
- Images professionally read by a licensed radiologist
- Patients needing MRIs, CT scans, mammograms or sonograms are referred to an outside provider in the community



Student Health Service

Medical Laboratory Services

- The Student Health Service Laboratory is a CLIA certified laboratory
- Staffed by licensed laboratory professionals



Student Health Service

Pharmaceutical Services

- Reasonably priced prescriptions, over-the-counter medications and diabetic supplies
- Students do not have to be a patient of the SHS to use the SHS pharmacy
- Current prescriptions can be transferred
- Most insurance plans accepted
- Staffed by licensed pharmacists and pharmacy interns

MMR Immunizations

The North Dakota State Board of Higher Education requires students enrolled in a course offered for credit at an institution in the North Dakota University System to submit documentation of immunity to the diseases of measles, mumps and rubella (MMR)

The MMR Immunization Requirement form should be completed by a licensed physician, nurse or authorized representative of a state or local health department and sent by mail or fax to:

Student Health Service

Tuberculosis (TB)

- Determine if your son/daughter needs to be screened for TB (risk factors located on the back of the MMR form)
- This requirement is most applicable to international students coming from countries where TB is endemic
- Students may receive a Mantoux (screening test for TB) at the Student Health Service

Student Health Service

Meningitis Vaccination

New for Fall Semester 2012

The North Dakota State Board of Higher Education requires all newly admitted students ages 21 and younger residing in campus housing to provide documentation of immunity against meningococcal disease
