Q: What qualifications are there to be on the Welcome Week Team?

Answer:

- Be enrolled as a student for the Fall 2025 semester as an NDSU student
- Be in good academic standing (minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA)
- Be in good disciplinary standing (not on behavioral probation) by 2025 Welcome Week

Q: What are the expectations of these positions?

Answer:

- Review expectations and accept position by Friday, May 9
- Attend required training(s) and events for your specific position
- Have an appreciation for and ability to work with people of diverse personalities & backgrounds
- Demonstrate a genuine enthusiasm for NDSU
- Be able to exercise good judgment while working with incoming students

Q: What are the benefits of joining the Welcome Week Team?

- Gain valuable leadership experience and develop transferable skills
- Build relationships with incoming students
- Contribute to a welcoming and inclusive NDSU community
- Network with NDSU administrators, faculty, staff and other student leaders
