*A teacher candidate is any NDSU student enrolled in any teacher preparation course or admitted to the NDSU School of Education.  - District and school policies at clinical placement sites

* Avoiding the following:

- Inappropriate electronic communication such as email, text messaging, social media, telephone calls and/or instant messaging with a student during a field placement.
- Using any platform not approved by the clinical placement site or outside of an educational purpose.
- Soliciting, encouraging, or consummating an inappropriate written, verbal, electronic or physical relationship with a student during a clinical placement.
- Using a professional relationship with a student for personal advantage or gain.
- Engaging in physical abuse of a student or sexual conduct with a student.
- Revealing confidential information concerning students unless disclosure serves lawful professional purposes or is required by law.
- Plagiarism as described in NDSU Policy 335.

Any violation of this code of conduct constitutes grounds for disciplinary action which may include but is not limited to:

- Issuance of a warning or reprimand (as outlined in the Admission and Retention Policy found in the NDSU Teacher Education Handbook)
- Assigned a grade of F for the enrolled course(s)
- Removal from clinical placement
- Suspension and/or dismissal from the program
