- 3. <u>Disabled</u> An individual who has a documented disability.

TO BE ELIGIBLE, YOU ONLY NEED TO MEET ONE OF THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS AT THE TIME YOU APPLY. ONCE YOUR APPLICATION IS REVIEWED AND YOU ARE ACCEPTED YOU ARE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE SERVICES FOR UP TO SIX (6) YEARS.
