Student Support Services (SSS) provides academic support to first-generation, income eligible, and students with disabilities. The SSS tutor program provides students with academic assistance and skill development necessary to achieve academic success through appointment-based, one-on-one tutoring.

# **General Qualifications:**

- Exceptional knowledge of course content and ability to communication subject material.
- Superb interpersonal communication skills and a desire to help fellow students.
- Ability to demonstrate patience and compassion in their tutoring.

# **Undergraduate Qualifications:**

- Must have completed a minimum of one semester at NDSU.
- A minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 and have received an A or B in the course they wish to tutor.
- Courses taken at NDSU are preferred.

### **Graduate Qualifications:**

- Must be currently enrolled in an NDSU program.
- Copy of undergraduate transcript showing successful degree completion, courses taken, and grades received.
- Prior tutoring experience a plus, but not required.

### **Expectations of the tutor include:**

- Attendance at all monthly staff meetings and workshops.
- A one academic year commitment.
- A minimum of 10 hours/week availability.
- Participation in an annual performance review and an exit interview.
- Completion of Tutor Certification.
- Assist with other projects as requested or assigned by Project Coordinator.

#### **Compensation:**

A minimum of 10 hours/week availability is required, with the understanding that 10 hours/week are not guaranteed. SSS tutors get compensated for actual hours tutored, tutor meetings, and tutor workshops. The pay scale is dependent on number of credits earned.

- Freshmen (0-26 credits) \$9.55
- Sophomore (27-59 credits) \$9.84
- Junior (60-89 credits) \$10.14
- Senior (90+ credits) \$10.45

- Bachelor Degree \$10.82
- Master's Degree \$12.10
- Ph.D Degree \$13.37
