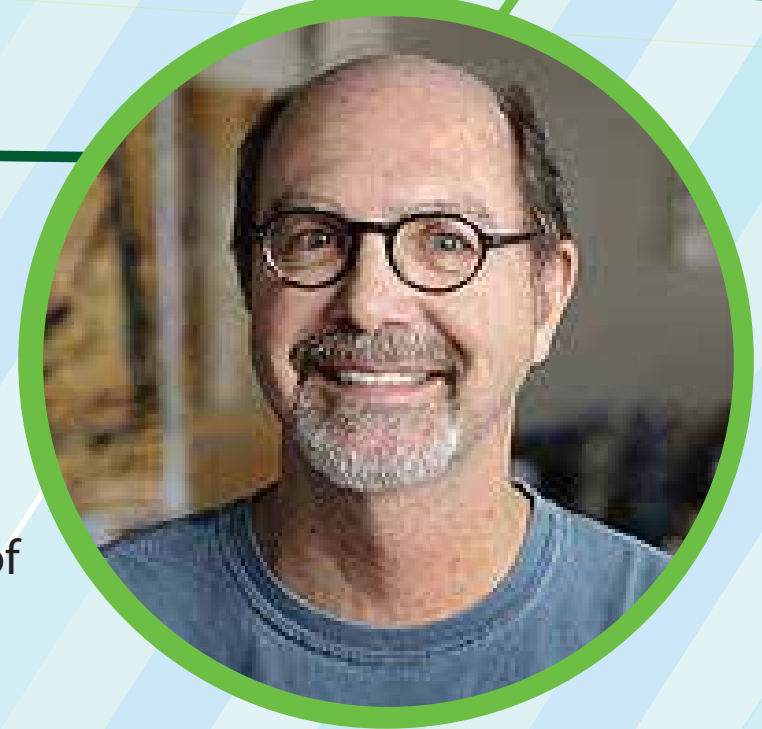

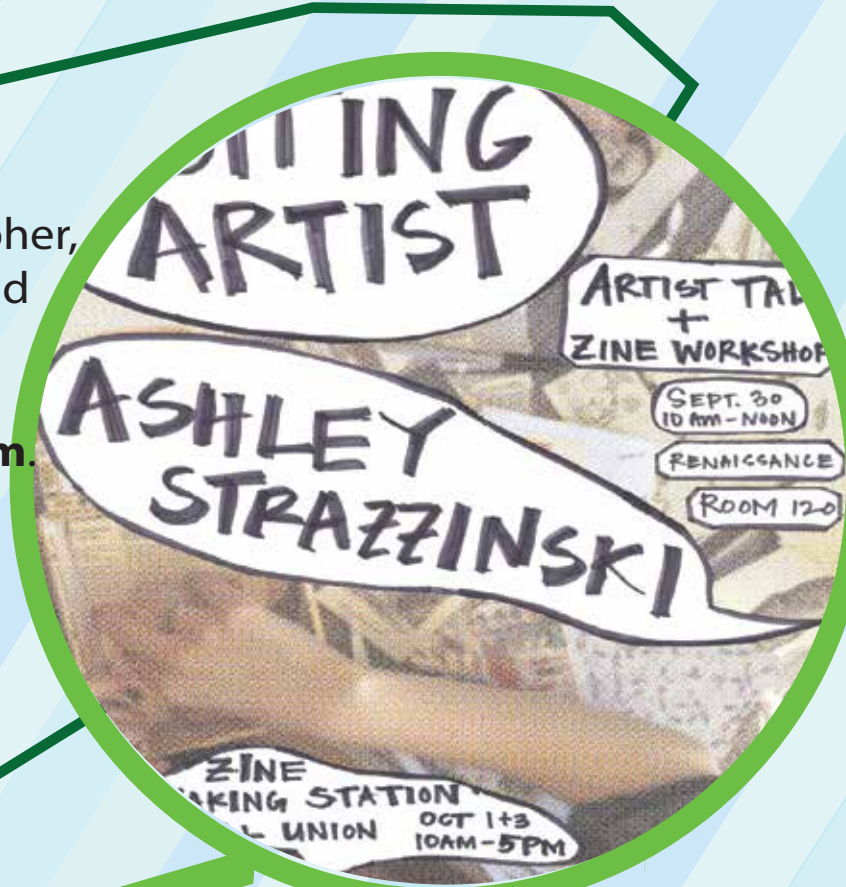

A reception will be held Friday, November 15, 2019 from 7:00 PM -10:00 PM. The exhibition will feature thousands of original artworks on 5X7 postcards by artists from 37 countries and most of the United States. This collaborative mail art project represents an inspired dialogue, transcending cultural differences through creative mediums.
