

Computer Lab Software Available with Remote Desktop

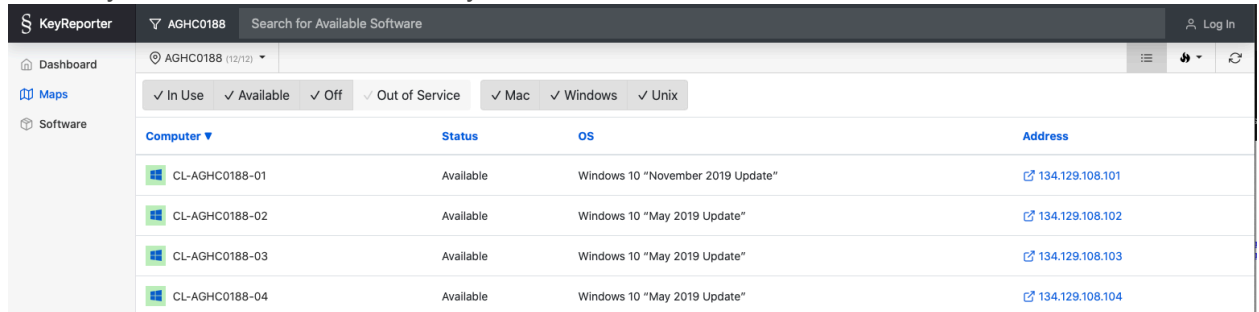
IT Division has enabled remote desktop into your classroom computers. This will allow you to access your classroom software like you would in person but just remotely. Follow the following steps to get there.

1. Go to this website - https://www.ndsu.edu/its/computer_labs_classrooms/computer_lab_details/
2. Each classroom that has remote access has a hyperlink enable on it.

3. It takes you to the list view of the lab you selected.



4. The linked IP is only shown for "Available" machines (off or logged out).
5. Clicking the link will download an RDP file for Windows targets which can then be opened to connect to the computer. Remote Desktop is built into Windows OS but Mac systems will need the Microsoft Remote Desktop app from the App Store to connect to a PC.
6. You will be prompted for credentials please use your first.last@ndsu.edu & NDSU Password.
7. Then it will prompt you for an MFA DUO push.
8. You are then logged into a campus computer lab machine.
9. When completed simply log out like you normally would on a lab machine.
