

## Viewing Blackboard Test Results as a Student

After taking a test in Blackboard, a student can access the grade earned through “Tools” and “My Grades” from within the Blackboard course by following these instructions:

1. From within the “My Grades” tool, find the Blackboard test in the list of grades and take the link to the test. (Note the grade awarded below the link.)
