Request for Delayed Release of a Master's Thesis, Master's Paper, or Doctoral Dissertation

North Dakota State University allows, upon the approval of your Advisor, Department Chair/Program Director, and the Graduate Dean, for the delayed release of Master's Papers, Master's Theses, and Doctoral Dissertations (Disquisitions). If a delayed release is approved, the delayed release time period begins on the last day of the semester in which the disquisition is approved. The Disquisition would not be made available to the public through ProQuest or the NDSU Institutional Repository during the time period requested. Also, if any printed copies are ordered through ProQuest they will not be delivered until the end of the requested time period. After the time period expires, your disquisition will be released for publication.

To request an extension to an approved delayed release time period, you must submit a Delayed Release Extension form directly to the Graduate School. Any additional extensions to the time period requested in the initial delayed release may only be approved by the Dean of the Graduate School. You will not be contacted regarding the expiration of your delayed release, and you are solely responsible for requesting any extensions to an approved delayed release.
