These scholarships were endowed in 1993 by Dr. John and Lillian Callenbach in recognition of the contributions of their daughter, Carolyn, to Phi Kappa Phi, North Dakota State University and her community. Dr. Callenbach, a 60 year Phi Kappa Phi member and NDSU emeritus professor, died in 1999. The memorial scholarships were added at that time. Mrs. Nelson was a 3-term president of Chapter 10 and retired from NDSU as senior lecturer emeritus in 2002. She is currently the State Senator from District 21 in Fargo and President of the National Federation of Music Clubs.

The Carolyn Nelson Scholarships are a minimum of \$1000. Applicants must be undergraduates, show leadership on campus and community and must exhibit involvement in the fine arts.

The John A. Callenbach Memorial Scholarships are a minimum of \$300. Applicants must be undergraduates and exhibit leadership on campus beyond their major field of study.
