## Example Itinerary:

EXIT onto Demers Ave. heading East. Take a RIGHT on County Road 2. Take a RIGHT on Highway 72 S. Garden is 3 miles on RIGHT side of road.

### 11am- [2] Tour Browning Art Gallery (15min Drive)

Head NORTH on Highway 72. Take a LEFT on County Road 2. Take a LEFT on Demers Ave. Take a RIGHT on 5th St. Gallery on RIGHT side.

### 12pm- [3] Lunch at Whitey's (5min Drive)

Head SOUTH on 5th St. Take a LEFT on Demers Ave. Whitey's is LEFT on first block across river.

### 1:15pm- [4] Visit Cabela's (2min Walk)

Across Demers Ave. from Whitey's.

### 2:30pm- [5] Visit Town Square Market (5min Drive)

South on Demers Ave. Corner of Demers Ave. and 3rd St.

### 3:30pm- [6] Performance at Empire Arts (3min Drive)

South on Demers Ave. Corner of Demers Ave. and 5th St.

### 6:30pm- [7] Dinner at Sander's (3min Walk)

North on Demers Ave. RIGHT on 4th St. Located on RIGHT side of road.

### 8:30pm- [8] O'Reilly's Irish Pub (5min Walk)

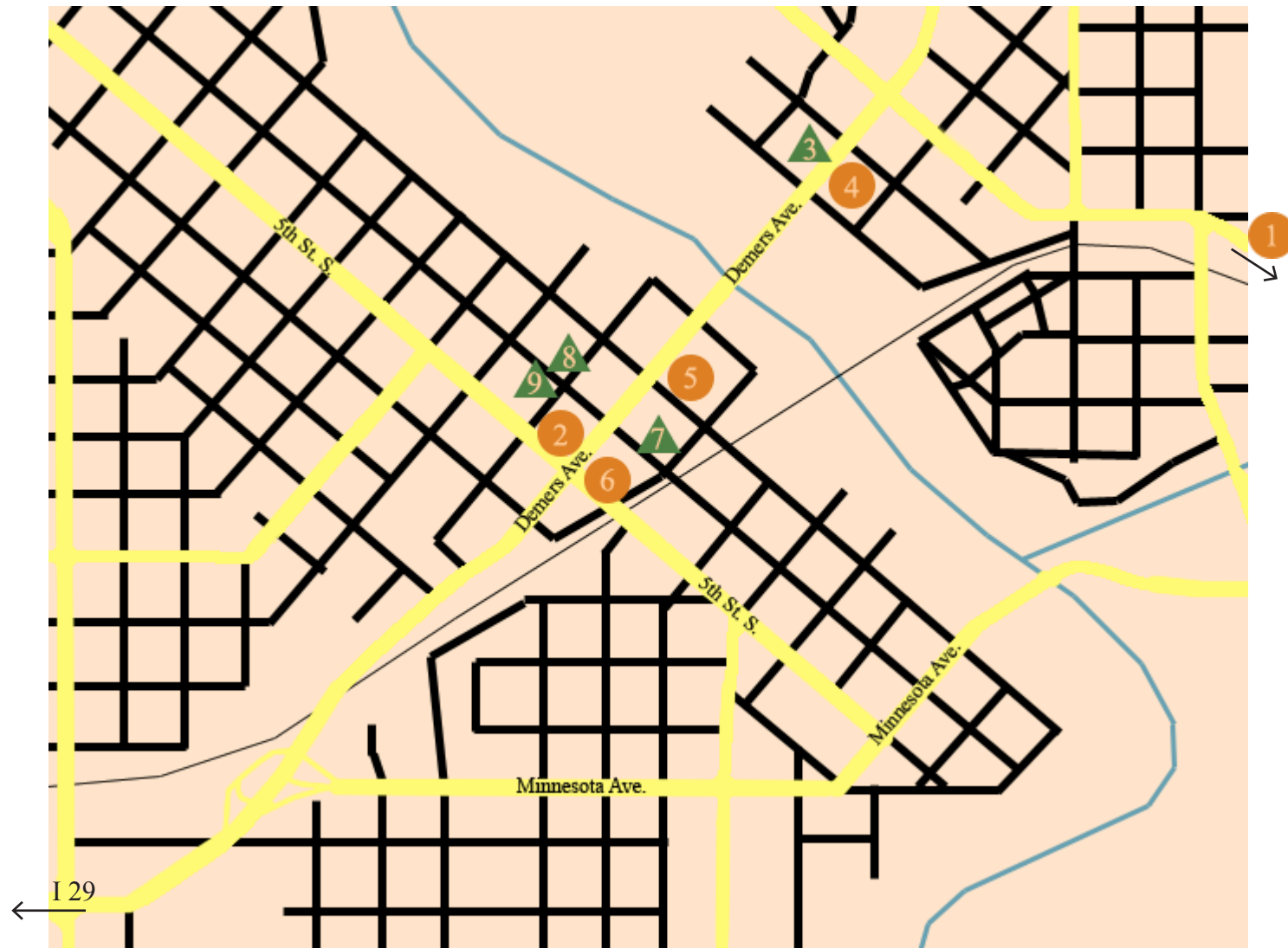
North on 4th St. 3 blocks. Located on RIGHT side of road.

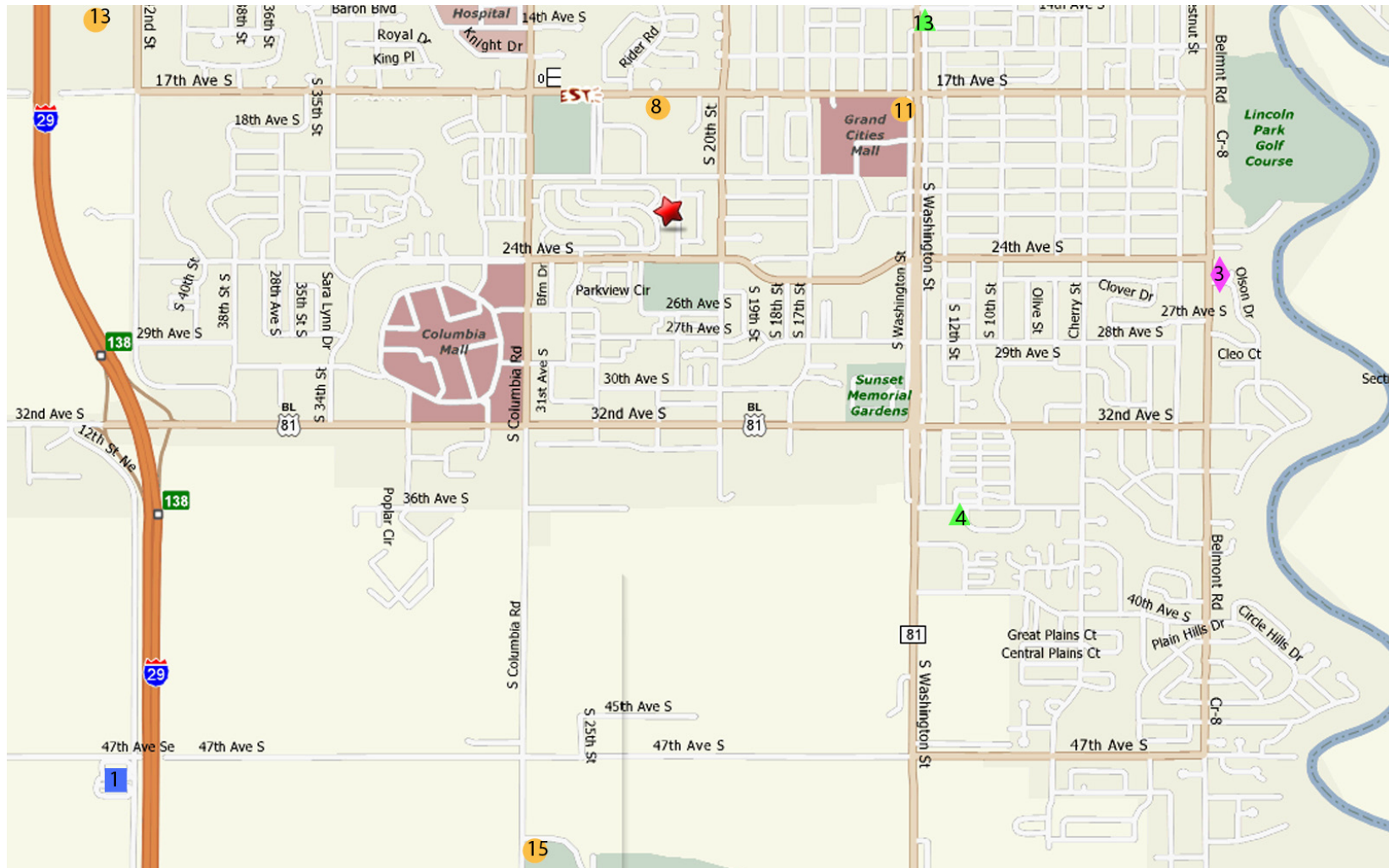

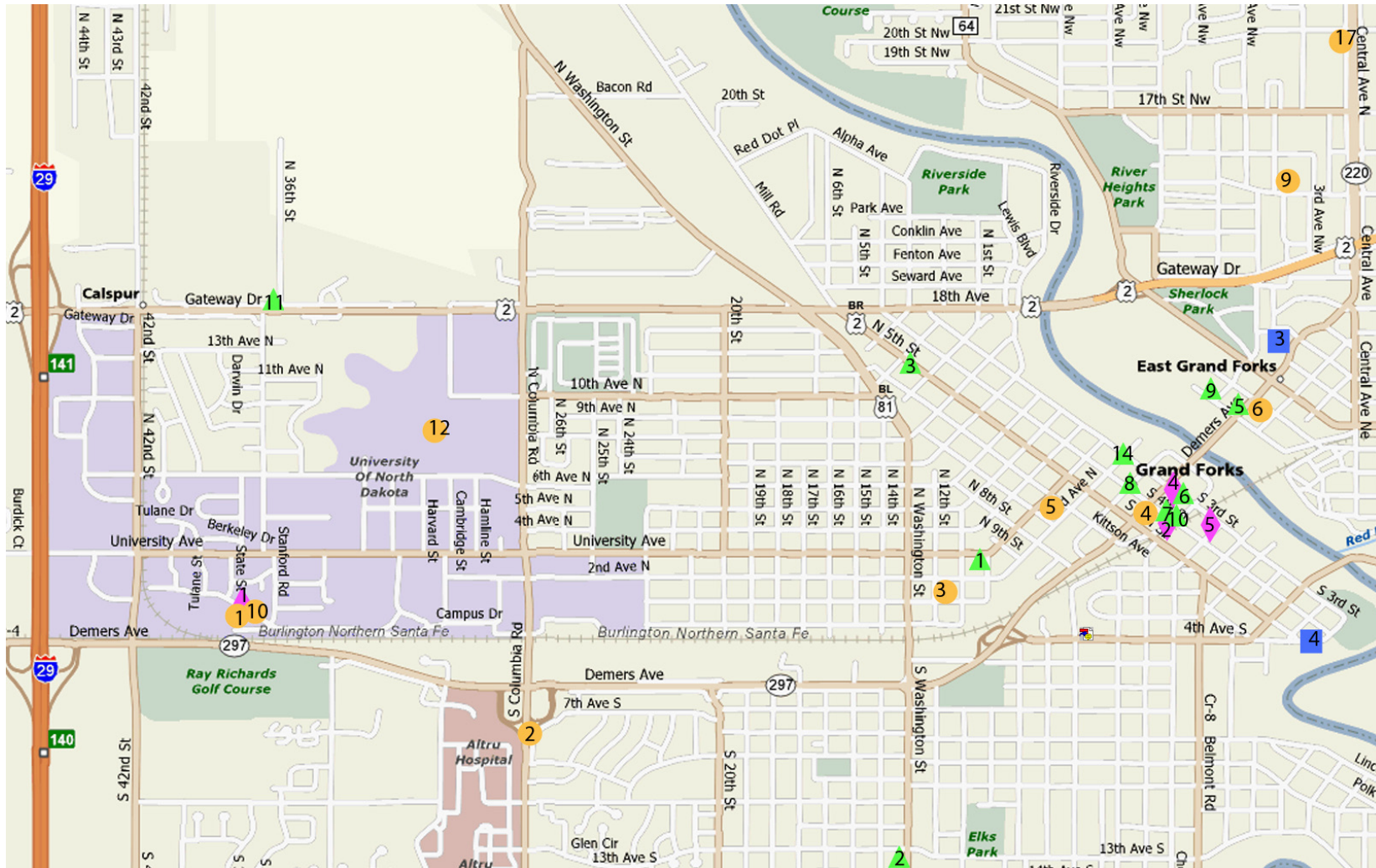

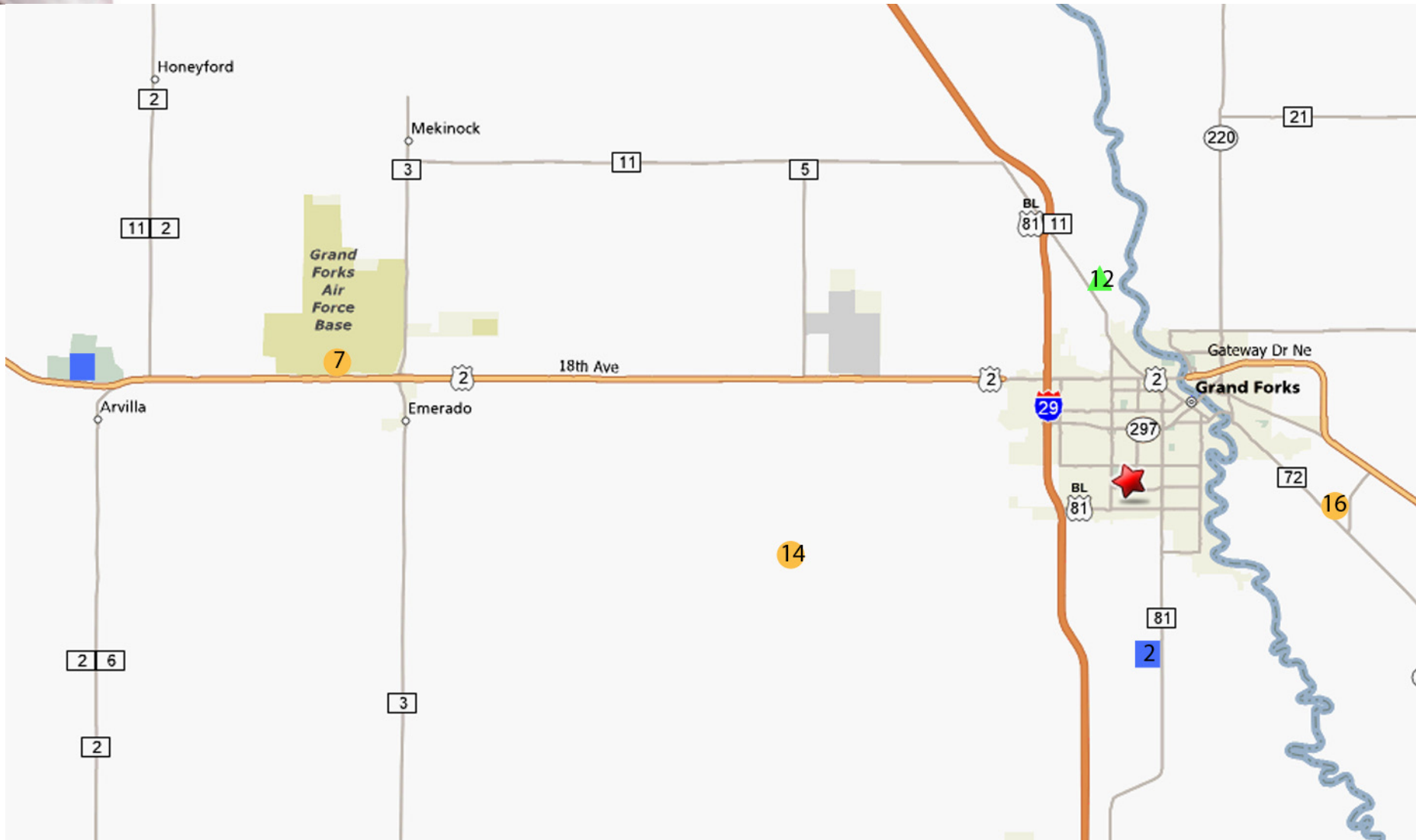

Provide a bike rental shop near the hotels and Visitors Center. Include biking lanes on the roads to minimize sidewalk traffic and give bikers their own route to follow while touring the city.



Convert small pathways between the Red River and dike system into a large framework of bike trails. These trails can be connected to adjacent cities through gravel bike paths with minimum maintenance.

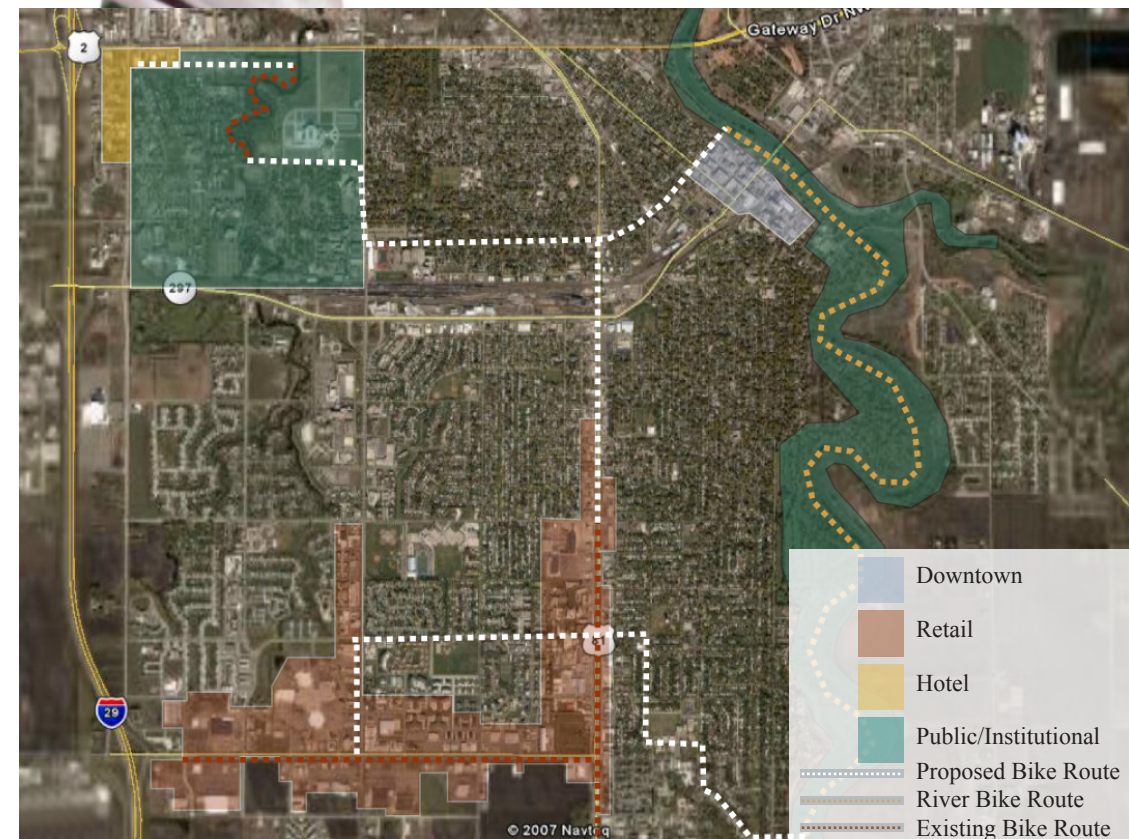




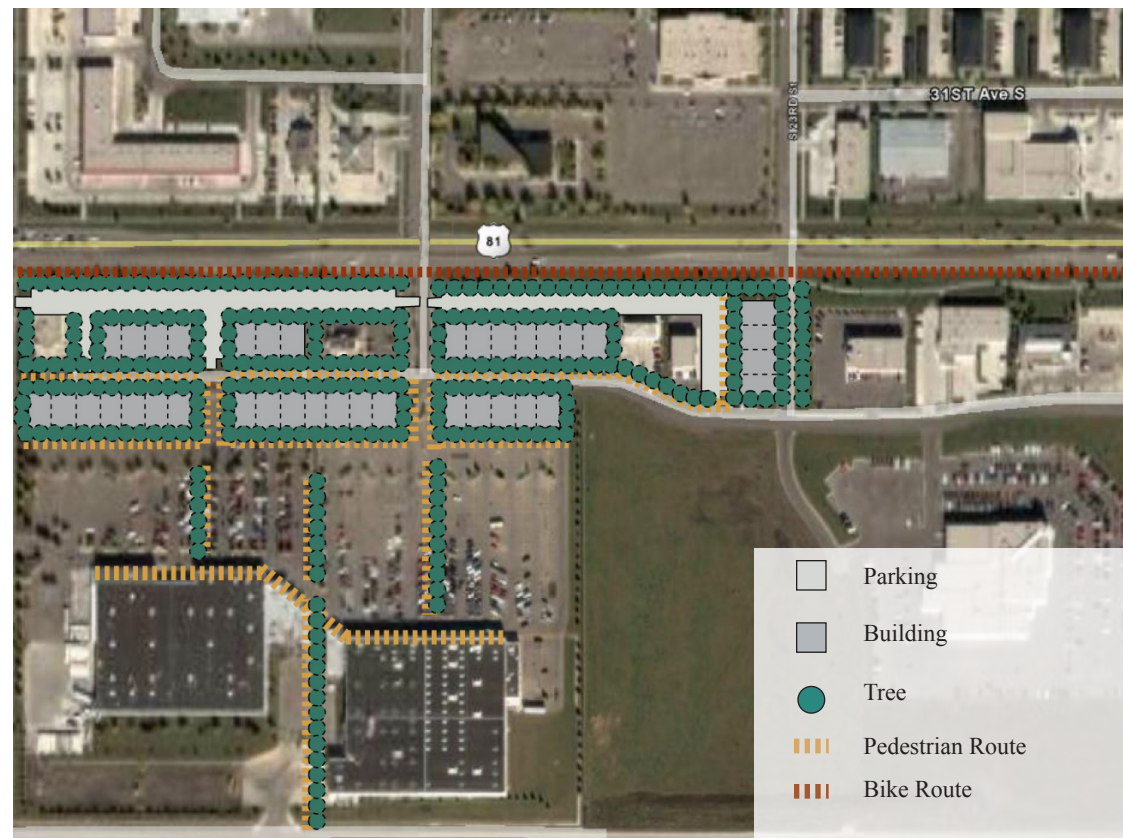

Beautify city routes between retail areas, including bringing in infilling parking lots with safe pedestrian routes lined with boulevard trees.



Connect major existing bike routes throughout the city. Add the ability for the city tourism facility to rent bikes to tourists in the hotel district of Grand Forks. Tie this newly expanded bike system into the proposed bike route along the river, and connect downtown Grand Forks and the commercial heart of southern Grand Forks.
