

North Dakota State University (NDSU) 2021 Summer Research Experiences for Undergraduate (REU)

This summer, NDSU is offering an undergraduate research experience program in a variety of science and engineering fields, with a focus on biotechnology. This program is intended to provide a coordinated, educational and dynamic research community to encourage research in undergraduate study.

WHERE:

- The North Dakota State University main campus in Fargo, ND.

WHEN:

- The majority of projects run for 6 weeks from June 21 to August 3, 2021.
- Some projects have 8-week durations and will begin June 7, 2021.

WHO:

- Undergraduate students who are currently enrolled in a degree program at a college or university and will not graduate before December 2021.

BENEFITS:

- Participants will receive a stipend of \$500/week (total of \$4,000 for 8-week program, \$3,000 for 6 weeks).
- On-campus housing will be included.
- Up to \$500 for research materials and supply for reimbursements.
- Travel funds may be available to participants with financial needs.

DEADLINE:

- Applications must be received by **March 15, 2021** for full consideration.
