GUIDELINES

- All Homecoming participants must be currently enrolled as a North Dakota State
 University student. No alumni or non-active chapter members are permitted to enter in
 any Homecoming competitions. Only those students who are listed in the current chapter
 rosters as published by myNDSU are permitted to enter in any of the Homecoming
 events. Chapters will be disqualified for failure to appropriately monitor their
 representatives at each event.
- 2. In accordance with federal, state, and local laws and policies set by North Dakota State University, the Greek governing bodies IFC & PHC: all Homecoming events will be alcohol free events (dry). Violation of this policy will be handled as follows:
 - a. An individual who is found to be in possession of alcohol and is approached by a Student Activities Staff member or NDSU official will be asked to dump out any open alcohol containers, and to forfeit all closed alcohol containers. The name and chapter affiliation of that person will be noted. If the individual refuses to dump out and/or forfeit their alcohol, they will be escorted from the event. Anyone escorted from an event will not be allowed to participate in any further Homecoming competitions. If found in violation, the NDSU Police Department will be contacted.
 - b. Any individual who is found to be under the influence of alcohol will be approached by a Student Activities Staff member or NDSU official and will be asked to leave the event. If they refuse to leave, they will be escorted from the event. Anyone escorted from an event will not be allowed to participate in any further Homecoming competitions. If the individual is a member of a chapter/team for an event, the team will be disqualified from the event. If found in violation, the NDSU Police Department will be contacted.
- 3. Arrive early to all events, as they will all start on time!
- 4. All points will be updated by noon the following day on the Fraternity and Sorority Life website (https://www.ndsugreek.com/)
- 5. Have Safe FUN this week, create memories, and meet some new people!
- 6. Decisions made by the University and Homecoming Committee are final.

INDIVIDUAL COMPETITIVE EVENT RULES

Homecoming BBQ and Pep Fest

- 1. Sponsored by the Homecoming Committee and Gate City Bank
 - a. It is free
 - b. There will be a sign in by the West Doors of the Memorial Union
 - c. Points divided by who has the highest percentage of people show up

First Place: 100 Second Place: 75 Third Place: 50

Medallion Hunt

- 1. Every day of Homecoming clues as to where the medallion is hidden will be posted on the Campus Attractions Website
 - a. www.ndsu.edu/campusattractions > click the Homecoming Tab
 - b. Hints will be released every half an hour.
- 2. The team who finds the medallion first must turn it into the Student Activities Office upon finding it.
 - a. When you find the medallion bring it to the Student Activities office.
 - b. Please make sure at least two members of your team turn in the medallion and take a photo before you leave.
- 3. Do not deface the medallion. Any team who defaces the medallion will get disqualified from the remainder of the medallion hunts and will not be allotted their winning points for finding the medallion.
- 4. Points will be awarded as follows:

200 Points to the overall winner

Banner Contest

- 1. Banners must be done on the sheet provided by the Fraternity and Sorority Life Office.
- 2. Banners will be distributed on Monday September 30th.
- 3. Banners will be displayed at a chapter's facility either hanging or standing outside of the designated facility chosen by the team. The location must be submitted via email to Jordan Dadez (jordan.dadez@ndsu.edu) by 5pm on Monday, October 7th.
- 4. Banners must be outside and secured by Tuesday, October 8th at 1pm. The Homecoming Committee will be coming around at that time to take pictures of the banners.
- 5. Banners shall not depict alcohol and/or drug uses, illegal acts, or slanderous statements, and shall be sensitive to all ethnic, racial, gender groups, and religions.
- 6. No banner shall contain political or controversial themes.
- 7. The banners must have all four corners secured.
- 8. Banners will be judged on the following criteria:

- a. Incorporation of bison pride
- b. Recognition of the organization who created the banner (their success, characteristics, traditions, etc.)
- c. Overall creativity and attention to detail
- 9. Points will be awarded as follows:

First Place: 200 Second Place: 150 Third Place: 100

Homecoming Float Decoration

- 1. There will be a sign in form on myNDSU.
- 2. Submit all members who were present during that day to receive points.
- 3. Points will be distributed according to the percentage of the team that assisted with float decoration.
 - i. 70% to 80% of team is present: 100 pointsii. 60% to 70% of team is present: 75 points
 - iii. 50% to 60% of team is present: 50 points

Serve with the Herd

- 1. This is a double point opportunity
- 2. Participants must sign up with the Volunteer Network in advance to participate.

- 3. Points will be awarded according to the chapter that has the largest percentage participate:
- 4. Points will be awarded as follows:

a. First Place: 400b. Second Place: 300c. Third Place: 200

Bison Trivia

- 1. The event will start at 6:00 pm and end at 8:00 pm, please be there at least 15 minutes early (5:45 pm) to sign in.
- 2. Sit in your teams when it is trivia time, your team can work together to answer the questions.
- 3. Appoint a team captain to answer the questions
- 4. There will be a buzzer that the team captain can use to buzz in, with the answer.
- 5. There must be at least one participant from each chapter participating in trivia, and if there is not a participant from each chapter, you will not receive any points.
- 6. Whoever wins trivia will win an extra 100 points
- 7. Points will be awarded based on attendance, and on who wins trivia
- 8. Points will be awarded as follows:
 - i. 70% to 80% of team is present: 200 points

ii. 60% to 70% of team is present: 150 pointsiii. 50% to 60% of team is present: 100 points
