A. VIDEO

In accordance with the requirements for my doctoral degree program, I am required to produce a dissertation video (the "Video"). I understand that NDSU is not required to use the Video or make it publicly available. I further understand that I am not entitled to any monetary consideration for NDSU's usage of the Video.
