• Cumulative Transfer GPA: 2.0

Transfer Recommendations

• Completion of Associate in Arts (AA) or Associate in Science (AS)

Special Notes

- If is highly recommended that a grade of B or higher is earned in prerequisite courses
- Students are expected to maintain a 2.75 GPA among all criminal justice courses and a cumulative 2.5 GPA in order to graduate
- B.S. option: Completion of minor or second major
 - o minor requirement waived with AA or AS, or 15 transferable credits of military service/education/training
- B.A. option: 2nd year foreign language proficiency coursework
