## **Program Admission Requirements**

- Selective Admission Program requires cumulative GPA of 3.0, a combined GPA of 2.75 amongst all science courses and completion of supplemental application.

#### **Transfer Recommendation**

- Completion of Associate in Arts (AA) or Associate in Science (AS)
  - This program has an accelerated masters option. It is recommended that students contact NDSU academic advising after the completion of prerequisite courses

- Program offers 2 options: Dietitian Education Program (DEP) with a Community and Sports Nutrition concentration and the Didactic Program (DPD)
- All courses must have a grade of C or better to be applicable to degree requirements.
- A B grade or higher is highly recommended for all science courses
- A minimum grade of B is required for HNES 250
