Admission Requirements

- Selective Admission Program requires cumulative GPA of 2.75 and Practical Nursing GPA of 3.0. Attained unencumbered LPN license.

Transfer Recommendations

- Completion of Associate in Arts (AA) or Associate in Science (AS)
 - Due to the nature of the program, an Associate in Applied Science (AAS), LPN (vocational) Diploma, or LPN certificate are acceptable

Special Notes

- It is highly recommended that students attain a grade of C or higher in all courses
- Students should have completed the NLN NACE II validation exams in Adult Health, Mental Health,
 Care of the Childbearing Family, and Care of the Child
- CPR for the Health Provider certification is required
- Due to North Dakota licensure requirements, an <u>on-campus clinical</u> is part of the program
