Admission Requirements

- **Selective Admission Program – Requires a minimum 2.75 GPA and current unencumbered RN license.**

Transfer Recommendations

- Completion of Associate in Arts (AA) or Associate in Science (AS)
 - Due to the nature of the major, the Associate of Applied Science (AAS) is also acceptable

Special Notes

- It is highly recommended that students attain a grade of C or higher in all courses
- CPR for the Health Provider certification is required
