- Selective Admission Program Requires a minimum 2.75 GPA and current unencumbered RN license.

Transfer Recommendations

- Completion of Associate in Arts (AA) or Associate in Science (AS)
 - Due to the nature of the major, the Associate of Applied Science (AAS) is also acceptable
