Completion of Associate in Arts (AA) or Associate in Science (AS)

Special Notes

- B.S. option: Completion of minor or second major
 - minor requirement waived with AA or AS, or 15 transferable credits of military service/education/training
- B.A. option: 2nd year foreign language proficiency coursework
- A cumulative GPA of 3.0 is required for all POLS courses
- Courses cannot meet more than one major requirement
