

INTERNATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL (SECONDARY)

If you are completing/have completed your **high school (secondary)** education outside the United States, you must submit the following if applying as a first-year student or as a transfer student with fewer than 24 transferable college credits at the time of application:

- 1) Official academic records for all institutions attended and national exams taken

Official Academic Records and National Exams

- a) Request that official transcripts be sent directly from your institution to NDSU
- b) We also accept the following versions of official transcripts from electronic delivery services

National Student Clearinghouse (send to Int'l Undergrad Admissions)
Parchment
Credentials eScrip-Safe
SMART/Joint Service Transcript
- c) If records are not in English, be sure to include a certified English translation
- d) If we are unable to verify your educational records, NDSU reserves the right to request an external credential evaluation report from a NACES member such as World Education Services or Educational Credential Evaluators
