ANDREW ESTRADA PHUONG



Andrew Estrada Phuong is an assistant professor in the Department of Education Studies at UC San Diego. He earned a master's degree from Harvard and a Ph.D. from UC Berkeley.

Dr. Phuong studies what makes great teaching transformational. His research examines how adaptive equity-oriented pedagogies (AEP), artificial intelligence, and professional development improve student achievement and positive psychosocial outcomes such as motivation, sense of self-efficacy, belonging, and reduced stereotype threat. He uses rigorous research designs and methods, including randomized controlled trials, multilevel regression modeling, and advanced qualitative techniques, to examine how evidence-based practices improve student learning.
