# NDSU, DSU sign statewide pharmacy partnership

NDSU and Dickinson State University have partnered to create two new academic pathways into NDSU's Doctor of Pharmacy program, a move that that will help fill workforce needs for pharmacists across North Dakota.

The landmark agreement bridging North Dakota's eastern and western borders establishes a three-year traditional pre-pharmacy pathway and a two-year Early Admission Pathway for DSU students, offering a streamlined route to pharmacy education while allowing students to remain in western North Dakota.
