CARRIE HAMMER

Associate Dean for Academic Programs

Carrie Hammer serves as the Associate Dean for Academic Programs for the College of Agriculture, Food Systems, and Natural Resources. Appointed in November 2024, she brings over two decades of experience in teaching, research and student engagement within the Department of Animal Sciences to her administrative role. A distinguished scholar in equine science, Hammer has made numerous contributions in nutrition, immunology and developmental programming. She has authored more than 160 scientific and outreach publications and is a passionate mentor, educator and advocate for agriculture. Her leadership is instrumental in shaping the college's academic vision, overseeing program development, student recruitment and retention, and scholarship administration. Outside of work, Hammer enjoys spending time with her husband and two sons, relaxing at the lake and traveling around the U.S. and abroad.



GREG LARDY

Joe and Norma Peltier Vice President for Agriculture

Gregory Lardy has served as Vice President for Agriculture at North Dakota State University since 2020. In April 2024, he was named the Joe and Norma Peltier Endowed Vice President for NDSU Agriculture. The role includes responsibilities as Dean of the College of Agriculture, Food Systems, and Natural Resources; Director of NDSU Extension; and Director of the North Dakota Agricultural Experiment Station. Lardy was raised on a farm and ranch near Sentinel Butte, N.D. He received his B.S. degree in Animal and Range Science from NDSU, his M.S. in Animal Science from the University of Missouri and his Ph.D. in Animal Science from the University of Nebraska. Lardy joined the faculty at NDSU in 1997 where he served as the state's beef cattle Extension specialist until 2009. From 2009 to 2018, he served as department head in Animal Sciences. In 2018 and 2019 he served as interim director of NDSU Extension and Acting Director of the North Dakota Agricultural Experiment Station. He also served as president of the American Society of Animal Science in 2013-2014. Lardy and his wife, Lynae, reside in West Fargo, North Dakota. They have three children and six grandchildren.

President

David Cook is the 15th president of North Dakota State University. Joining NDSU in May 2022, his leadership focuses on the university's strategies to enhance enrollment and invest in student retention and success, prioritize NDSU's R-1 Carnegie classification status for research, invest in the well-being of the NDSU community, strengthen a culture of diversity, inclusion and respect and embrace NDSU's critical role as a land-grant university. He currently serves on the board of directors for the following organizations: Ag Products Utilization Commission, Fargo Moorhead West Fargo Chamber, Greater Fargo Moorhead Economic Development Corp., Red River Valley Fair, Research and Technology Park, Research Foundation, Sanford Medical Center Fargo, State Board of Agricultural Research and Education, as well as the NDSU Foundation Executive Governing Board (ex-officio). Prior to NDSU, Cook held executive leadership roles of vice chancellor for the Office of Public Affairs and Economic Development at the University of Kansas, and the vice chancellor of the KU Edwards Campus in Overland Park, Kansas. Cook also spent 14 years at the University of Kansas Medical Center where he earned tenure and served as a member of the leadership cabinet. He and his wife, Kate, have three children – Gage, Ella and Peyton. They have two dogs, a goldendoodle named Motley and a sheepadoodle named Lola.
