#### **Langdon REC 2027/29 Request**

The Langdon REC hosts large agronomy, pathology and foundation seedstocks program work impacts.

Additionally, we employ two extension specialists in soil health and cropping systems. All programs have adequate personnel at this time. No fte Requests

In the past 25 years we have updated our headquarters building, agronomy lab, greenhouse addition, equipment storage shed and expect completion of the seed conditioning plant by June 2027. No Capital Project Requests!

The most critical issue for the LREC right now is lack of operating funds. Our current ratio of hard dollar salary compared to operating is 87 percent salary to 13 percent operating when recommendations for a healthy ratio would be 70 percent hard dollar salary to 30 percent operating.
