Cooperative Fire Protection Assistance Grant Overview

Program Administrator This grant is administered by the North Dakota Forest Service (NDFS) in cooperation

with USDA Forest Service (USFS).

Application Requirements

Funds Available Grant funds will be available for the purposes of enhancing fire protection and prevention capabilities

of ND Fire Departments (FD). These funds may be used for vehicle purchases, equipment, personal

protective equipment, firefighter training, fire awareness, and prevention efforts.

Cost-Share Requirements The applicant must match at least 50% of the total cost of the project from sources other than the

federal government. This amount may be in the form of cash, services, or in-kind contributions.

Maintenance Requirements The FD gives NDFS permission to examine all records related to purchases or projects receiving grant

funds consistent with the Cooperative Fire Agreement to ensure compliance with the program. Additionally, NDFS will conduct a biannual inventory on department awarded grant-funded vehicles.

Only FDs that service a population of 10,000 or less are eligible to submit an application.

FD **MUST** report all wildfires to NDFS utilizing ESO, the online fire reporting tool.

FDs must be recognized by and have a valid 2025 Certificate of Existence on file with the State Fire Marshal. They must also be National Incident Management System (NIMS) compliant.

FDs must have a signed Cooperative Fire Agreement with NDFS. Contact Aaron at 701-328-9946 or Aaron.bucholz@ndsu.edu to complete an agreement.

FDs must attach cost estimate or quote sheets for equipment and vehicles to the application. If using an online website, send a copy of the items in the cart or basket. Do not send catalog pages or website pages.

If applying for communication and wildland equipment, PPE, training and tools, one application can be used for all of these items. If applying for a vehicle, a separate application is required. FD's may apply for both types of grants within the same year.

No handwritten application will be accepted.

Application Deadline Applications must be emailed or postmarked by 03/06/2026. Late applications will not be accepted.

Awards Applicants will be notified via an award letter sent to the address listed on the grant application.

Applicants cannot order or purchase any items to be reimbursed before the arrival of an official NDFS award letter. Estimate(s) or quote(s) are required to be included when submitting the grant application.

FD must provide proof that the items were ordered by submitting invoices with the description of the item(s) ordered to NDFS.FireGrants@ndsu.edu before April 30, 2026.

Award letters will specify what items may be purchased with the awarded grant funds. Any deviation from what is included within the award letter will result in being ineligible for reimbursement.

Please use the category information listed below when completing the grant application.

The following grant categories listed in order of priority are eligible for the Cooperative Fire Protection Assistance Grant (CFPA) 50% cost-share program:

1. Vehicles - Use the VEHICLE application form if applying for a vehicle grant.

As a 50/50 cost share grant, NDFS will award up to \$25,000 for a vehicle grant award. A FD may spend more than \$50,000 but the maximum award amount cannot exceed \$25,000.

Brush truck, command vehicle, pumper, water tender or UTV

2. Wildland PPE

As a 50/50 cost share grant, NDFS will award up to \$15,000 for a non-vehicle grant award.

A FD may spend more than \$30,000 but the maximum award amount cannot exceed \$15,000.

• Wildland pants, shirts, shelter, boots, helmets, and gloves, etc.

3. Communications Equipment & Training

As a 50/50 cost share grant, NDFS will award up to \$15,000 for a non-vehicle grant award.

A department may spend more than \$30,000 but the maximum award amount cannot exceed \$15,000.

- Radios, pagers (must be P-25 compliant)
- Priority is given to NWCG and ICS courses

4. Wildland Fire Equipment

As a 50/50 cost share grant, NDFS will award up to \$15,000 for a non-vehicle grant award.

A department may spend more than \$30,000 but the maximum award amount cannot exceed \$15,000.

- Fire line tools, pulaskis, shovels, flappers, etc.
- Pumps, hose, drop tanks, etc.
- Skid unit assemblies

5. Structural Firefighting PPE

As a 50/50 cost share grant, NDFS will award up to \$15,000 for a non-vehicle grant award.

A FD may spend more than \$30,000 but the maximum award amount cannot exceed \$15,000.

• Structure turnout gear, helmets, boots, air packs, etc.

6. Structural Firefighting Equipment

As a 50/50 cost share grant, NDFS will award up to \$15,000 for a non-vehicle grant award.

A FD may spend more than \$30,000 but the maximum award amount cannot exceed \$15,000.

Structural firefighting tools - Includes but not limited to pike poles, ventilation saws, generators, etc.

IMPORTANT:

For all categories other than vehicle, a <u>single piece of equipment may not cost more than \$10,000</u>. If a FD fails to comply, reimbursement will be denied.
