

COVID CAN BE SERIOUS FOR INFANTS AND YOUNG CHILDREN.




While kids are at lower risk of severe illness from COVID than adults, it is nearly impossible to predict who will experience severe outcomes.

THE COVID SHOT

Everyone ages 6 months and older should receive an updated COVID vaccine to protect against the potentially serious outcomes of COVID this fall and winter whether or not they have ever previously been vaccinated.



BENEFITS
