- The boundaries for zip code 58710 changed slightly between 1990 and 2000 (see boundary maps). Therefore, an assessment of change between 1990 and 2000 using these data is not appropriate.
- In 1990, zip code 58710 encompassed a small section of the far southeastern corner of McHenry County and the north central section of Sheridan County with 477 residents. A boundary change in 2000 expanded the area to include the far southwestern corner of Pierce County. The new area had 585 residents in 2000.
- McHenry County experienced a decline in population between 1990 and 2000. Population projections for McHenry County indicate that population declines are likely to continue over the next two decades.
- In 2000, 22 percent of residents in zip code 58710 were younger than 20 years of age and 29 percent were ages 65 and older. This age profile is slightly different from McHenry County in which youth comprised 26 percent of the population and elderly comprised 22 percent. Population projections for McHenry County indicate a rapidly growing elderly population will likely occur over the next two decades.
- In 2000, nearly all residents in both zip code 58710 and McHenry County were white.

- The boundaries for zip code 58710 changed slightly between 1990 and 2000 (see boundary maps). Therefore, an assessment of change between 1990 and 2000 using these data is not appropriate.
- The number of housing units declined in McHenry County between 1990 and 2000. In 2000, 78 percent of housing units in zip code 58710 and 69 percent in McHenry County were owner-occupied.
- McHenry County experienced a decline in vacant housing units between 1990 and 2000. In 2000, vacant housing comprised 15 percent of all housing in McHenry County and 11 percent in zip code 58710.
- In 2000, the median value of an owner-occupied home in zip code 58710 was \$26,000, compared to \$32,600 in McHenry County.
- In 2000, half of all housing units in zip code 58710 were built before 1946; half of all housing units in McHenry County were built before 1955.

- The boundaries for zip code 58710 changed slightly between 1990 and 2000 (see boundary maps). Therefore, an assessment of change between 1990 and 2000 using these data is not appropriate.
- The median household income in zip code 58710 was \$30,588 in 2000, compared to \$27,274 in McHenry County. When the 1990 median values are adjusted for inflation, the 2000 median household income represents an increase in purchasing power for McHenry County residents.
- McHenry County experienced a decline in the number and proportion of people living below poverty between 1990 and 2000. However, approximately 16 percent of residents in both zip code 58710 and McHenry County were impoverished in 2000.
- McHenry County experienced a significant decline in the number of impoverished children and little change in the number of impoverished elderly between 1990 and 2000. In 2000, 28 percent of impoverished residents in McHenry County were children and 22 percent were elderly. In contrast, 21 percent of impoverished residents in zip code 58710 were children and 38 percent were elderly in 2000.
