How can visualization tools illuminate literature, history and writing?

The emerging methodologies of digital humanities will be explored in this intensive weeklong seminar for graduate students. Cordell, who teaches courses titled Digital Humanities and Technologies of Text, will investigate both the affordances and pitfalls for how new technologies can be used to study texts in both research and the classroom.

Students will learn “deep mapping,” which overlays historical maps, census data, text, photographs and other geo-spatial layers to create complex arguments related to their scholarly interest.
