Responsibilities:

- Must maintain a minimum of 3.0 GPA for duration of the appointment;
- Ability to work with diverse groups of students;
- Strong oral, written, and interpersonal communication skills in the English language;
- Proficient in computer skills and document preparation (e.g. Microsoft Office);
- Attention to detail; ability to work independently and carry out tasks to completion.

Terms of Employment: Appointment requires 10-20 hours per week, Appointment begins August, 15, 2022 and ends June 30, 2023.
